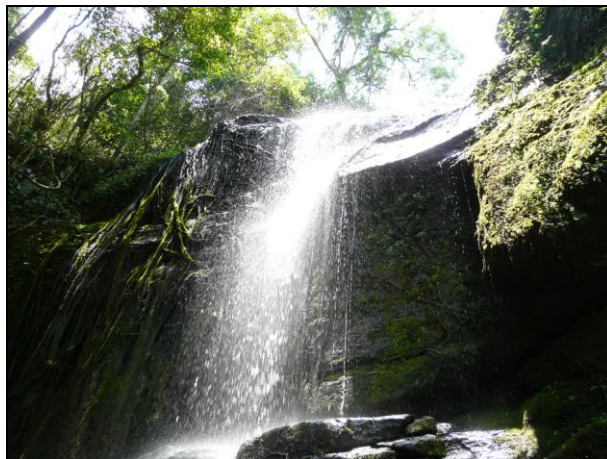


The Resort

Located on a hilltop the resort offers a unique view over the National Park and surrounding mountain ranges as well as spacious and comfortable bungalows in traditional Thai style.



The resort comprises just 28 spacious Thai style bungalows in a tropical garden setting. The resort aims to recreate the look and feel of a local Thai village and blends naturally with the surrounding world heritage site of Khao Yai. Guests can enjoy the serenity and tranquility of the area and visit the dense jungle of Khao Yai, the many waterfalls or spend the day trekking throughout the park.



Samanea is probably the only resort in Khao Yai from which you can easily take a short walk or a long hike directly into Khao Yai National Park, the UNESCO World Heritage Site, to visit nearby waterfalls and explore the abundant flora and fauna.

The Khao Yai National park

The park was established in 1962 as Thailand's first national park. Today the 2.168 sq Meter large world heritage site includes parts of the Nakhon Rachasima, Saraburi, Nakhon Nayok and Prachinburi provinces. The mountain ranges of Khao Yai are covered with dense jungle and comprise a natural border between the lowlands of central Thailand and the highlands of northeastern Thailand – the Isan. The park serves as a nature reserve for many wild animals and is an important source of water for the rice fields of central Thailand.

Geography & Climate

With 1.351m Khao Rom mountain is the highest peak of Khao Yai. The average height however is 700m above sea level and the area offers with an average temperature of just 23 degrees Celsius year round a cooler climate than central or northeastern Thailand.



Rooms & Facilities

The resort features 28 Deluxe and Family bungalows. All 48 sqm Bungalows are situated in a lush tropical garden on a mountain overlooking the national park.

How to get there

The Khao Yai National Park is located approximately 160km north of Bangkok.

Per car or transfer the park and the resort can be reached in just under 2 hours. The drive leads first from Bangkok north over the highway No. 1 to Saraburi. Then past highway No.2 towards Nakhon Rachasima. Near the town of Pak Chong you will find the Exit to Khao Yai. From here the Highway No. 2090 leads directly to the park.
